NOTICE OF RACE

•RULES

- The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing published by the US Sailing Association.
- The class rules shall be the rules of the FJ class.
- Certain rules may be changed and these changes will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions.

•ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

- Eligibility: Members of Taylor Pond Yacht Club in good standing may skipper. Members and current year sailing students at Taylor Pond Yacht Club may crew. Skippers must be experienced and able to race an FJ safely and without damage.
- Entry: Enter by notifying the committee of intent to race by email to petergarcia207@gmail.com or by completing signup list posted in Junior and Senior clubhouses not later than noon, Wednesday, August 4, 2022. Entry must identify skipper and crew. In the event more than six qualified entries are received, the Committee may schedule elimination races, and may establish a boat rotation schedule which calls for one or more crews to sit out each race so that the regatta can be accomplished in the available boats.

•BOATS

- The regatta will be sailed in the Flying Junior sloops provided by the Taylor Pond Yacht Club.
- Boats will be assigned to competitors by lot as determined by the Committee.
- Competitors will be responsible for boat damage other than normal wear and tear.

•SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Competitors should be prepared to race 2 days

Saturday, August 6, 2022.

Competitor briefing at 12 noon sharp. First race to begin at 1 PM. Weather permitting, at least 6 races are planned. Racers should come prepared to race without interruption as the Committee will schedule races as quickly as conditions allow in order to complete the scheduled races, last race to start not later than 6 PM.

Sunday, August 7, 2022, if necessary:

First race to begin at 1 PM. Racers should come prepared to race without interruption as the Committee will schedule races as quickly as conditions allow in order to complete the scheduled races, last race to start not later than 6 PM.

Awards presentation: Monday, September 5, 2018, 3 PM.

- SAILING INSTRUCTIONS - The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors briefing.

- SCORING - A minimum of 6 races are scheduled, of which 1 or such greater number as the Committee determines is a fair contest must be completed to constitute a series.

- SAFETY - A US Coast Guard approved personal flotation device shall be worn, properly fastened, at all times when sailing. Failure to comply with this rule may result in disqualification.

- PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded to skippers and crews placing first through third in the championship series.
